SECURITAS

We continue to be secure here at The Fairways. Our newly installed entrance and exit gates have been functioning properly. During daytime hours our community has been continuously safe with no incidents reported. Evening security as reported by Securitas indicates that we have again been secure at our Clubhouse, streets, and all pools without incident.

STOP! Please adhere to the STOP SIGN at the entrance of the Clubhouse roundabout for the safety of our pedestrians, pets and be sure to yield to vehicles in the roundabout before entering! Also please be sure to observe the speed limit in our community - 15 mph!

WALKING IN THE EVENINGS: As evenings draw in earlier these days, if you are walking at night, please do so with caution and wear light colored clothing, or neon safety strips, or a reflective vest and carry a flashlight. If you are walking with your fur baby, please consider outfitting him or her with a reflective vest and/or lit collar. Here's to a merry and safe December to us all!

FACILITIES ~ Kirk Gardner

LIGHTING: We are still experiencing issues with the St Andrews Plaza light string that our electrician has been working on to resolve. The Pool 5 light is also still not operational. Hopefully, both issues can be resolved within the next few weeks.

LAMP POSTS: Numerous lampposts have now been repainted or repaired thanks to two teams of volunteers made up of Ursula Serpico/Peter Brenner and Kat Schon/Penny Stephenson. Our goal is to repaint all 102 lampposts by the end of January. If you see a nonoperational lamppost please put a yellow flag next to it found at most of our dumpster enclosures. And please be sure to say thanks to our team members as you come upon them for all their good work.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Committee member Geoff Cross has singlehandedly cleaned and weeded all 9 of our fire hydrant areas. In conjunction with his efforts, Desert Water Agency was contacted and in short order they came onsite and painted each hydrant as well as field tested them for proper operational status.

<u>GUTTER AREAS</u>: Geoff has also been systematically cleaning the gutter areas of built up dirt in the joints that grass has been growing in since the reseeding. It not only improves the street aesthetic but reduces the water build up as the areas serve to dam up the water run off.

STRIP & CURB PAINTING: The annual parking lot stripping and red curb painting projects are completed thanks to the efforts of Ursula Serpico, Peter Brenner, Bill Albert and Geoff Cross. In conjunction with these projects it was observed that the stop sign at the Main Exit at Lawrence Crossley Road was obliterated. A call to the Palm Springs City Maintenance Department resulted in the city replacing the stop sign with a new one.

We have replaced the frayed Pickleball Net with a newer used net. We have assembled and cleaned the two portable Pickleball Nets & they are available for use on the adjacent court.

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<u>Community Member Spotlight:</u> <u>Frank Perra & Lana Nikonetz</u>

Two members of our Fairways HOA Board of Directors are retiring this year - HOA Board President- Frank Perra & HOA Treasurer- Lana Nikonetz! Both have selflessly served and volunteered their time and energies in bettering our Fairways Community for many, many years!



With Frank as President and Lana as Treasurer, the Fairways has overcome many challenges and obstacles. When Frank and Lana assumed their positions, the Fairways community and HOA had been neglected, was financially troubled with little or no monetary reserves to its name and needed bold leadership.



Under Frank's tenure, and with the assistance of other like-minded board members, committee chairs and community volunteers, an HOA in decline was set on a path of financial & stable order.

Here are but a few of the many goals accomplished:

- Built the HOA reserve from less than a \$100,000 to the current 1.1 million;
- Created a 5 year operational/business plan for the HOA where before there had been none;
- Secured a management company representative (ie.: Rhianna from Desert Management) on site to serve our community;
 - Started a Reserve Study , i.e. Maintenance Plan , to project HOA needs and costs in the future;

• Created a Governance Committee which has reviewed CC&Rs (approved by ownership in 2021) ; Rules and Regs (approved in 2022) and Architectural Guidelines;

• Opened the dialogue with the Indian families about the Fairways land lease extension (expiring in 2037), and continues to this day those land lease negotiations. Final proposals were presented to the Indian families in July 2022 - current status now resides with the Bureau of Indian Affairs who is reviewing the draft leases. Frank will continue leading this effort;

• Created a comprehensive roof repair and replacement plan whereby all roofs will be repaired by 2024. (Prior to this effort, each owner had paid a \$5k assessment plus the HOA secured a \$300k loan but very few roofs were actually repaired);

 Began the process of changing the annual plants to desertscape in medians and circles and started the plan to expand hardscape throughout the property taking advantage of the Desert Water Agency Grass Rebate program and also to provide significant water savings;

• Created and nutured a volunteer force of HOA residents to remodel the clubhouse facilities; annually paint the emergency curbs; clean the light fixtures; paint the maintenance shed etc...and other such tasks resulting in significant savings to the community.

Under Frank's leadership, Lana's financial skillfulness and with the efforts of many others in our community, the combination of money invested in the Fairways in addition to the volunteer work investment totals close to \$2 million. As we welcome a new Board in 2024, Frank and Lana's legacy will be remembered for their efforts of creating sound business plans to follow and rebuilding a strong financial base for the Fairways Community to step forward into the future!



We all owe them our sincere thanks and a standing ovation for a job well done. Thank you, thank you! Frank and Lana for your many years of service to the Fairways community and best wishes!
