Organic Recycling is Here.....Those green trash cans near each dumpster area are for Organic Recycling. August Martinez from the Palm Springs Disposal Service gave an informative presentation to homeowners at last month's boad meeting about what is Oraganix Reycling and what can be placed in those green trash cans....

What Goes in the Organic Recycling Green Can?

Items You Can Place in the Green Can: Coffee Grounds • Cooked Meat including Bones • Food Scraps • Food Soiled Paper • Grass Clippings • Leaves • Palm Fronds • Tea Bags • Tree + Shrub Trimmings • Twigs + Small Branches • Yard Trimmings • Weeds

Place your FOOD WASTE in a clear plastic or white bag. Place the bag in the green can along with the loose yard waste or clippings. Bagging your food will help with odor as well as with the sorting process at the processing facility.



FACILITIES ~ Kirk Gardner Clubhouse



The Clubhouse annual deep cleaning has been completed. Recycling bins have been purchased for Clubhouse events in order to properly recycle items that heretofore have been thrown out with the trash. Facilities

Virtually all the lampposts have been painted, and twice weekly any illumination issues are addressed. If you are aware of either a lamppost or landscape light in need of attention please

put a yellow flag near it (most dumpster enclosures have colored flags available) and let Desert Management - Rhianna Beverly at rbeverly@desertmanagement.com, know the approximate location.



Pools

Pool servicing issues and concerns are being addressed by the committee, brought to light by Bill Albert who has been monitoring pool chemistry and observing non-standard readings. Four invited vendors have completed pool site visits and provided information, suggestions, recommendations and proposals for pool servicing. The committee will research, review and submit recommendations to the Board for possible vendor action.

The Board authorized approximately \$5872 to address the pool and equipment issues at Pool 4.

Bill is working with vendor - Pools by Eric - to bring this pool back to operational status as well as improve the equipment and enclosure to establish a higher visual esthetic and operational standard. Pool 4 will probably have the plaster acid washed to remove the built up calcium that is infused with debris. A scheduled plan to review all our pools is being worked on to upgrade and raise our pools operational and efficientcy standards.

Our annual Riverside County Health Department inspection will probably occur in the next 8 weeks for pool operating permit renewal. Health Department code standards are being addressed with worn items like signage being replaced and safety mandates reviewed.

Road Resealing

The Fairways roads were last resealed in July of 2018. The recommended service frequency for road resealing is 5 years and is increasingly important to complete as the road asphalt ages. Our roads were replaced in 2003 by Matich Corp. at a cost of \$273k. Replacement cost today would be approximately \$1.2 million.

At 21 years of age (reserve study service life is 20 years) our roads are rated in good condition by one asphalt vendor proposal and in need of replacement by another asphalt vendor proposal. Realistically, the committee views the reseal option viable and would probably suffice to extend the Fairways roads service life for 5 to 10 years. Additional proposals are being sought so the committee can reviéw and recommend possible action for the Boards consideration.

We are keeping a watchful eye on the safety and security of our community

with emphasis this month on the perimeter walls. We have reassessed our needs for securing these areas and we will be installing 15 new pyracanthas and put wrought iron fencing in compromised areas.

This represents a team effort with the Security and Landscape Committees. As always it is incumbent on each owner at The Fairways to take a good look at one's property and make certain your home is visibly secure to intruders.
